This stucco rendered brick house has a corrugated iron gambrel roof with a hipped roof to the main room. A separate bull nose verandah supported on timber posts has trellis infill. The main room has a decorative diamond shaped feature above the aluminium awning which shades the centrally placed window. Windows are casement style. There are two tall rendered brick chimneys to the west and east. A fibro lean-to has been added to the west side. A timber picket fence forms the property frontage.
