This is one of a pair of semi detached rendered brick houses with an aluminium tiled roof. The roof is hipped to the north end with a separate gable to the front which has a small finial and pendant. The gable end contains a small hipped roof to a bay. To the north east of the bay a separate verandah has a decorative lacework frieze and balustrade with a brick enclosure to the north. The openings to the front facade under the verandah are quoined with red tuckpointed brickwork. Windows to the bay are aluminium framed with small awnings and aluminium security grilles. Rendered masonry chimneys to the north, west and south are tall and corbelled with terra cotta chimney pots. There is a fibro enclosed lean-to to the rear with a corrugated iron roof. A low rendered masonry wall forms the street boundary of the property. (See also 82 Gregory Street.)
