This small timber framed weatherboard clad cottage has a gable corrugated iron roof with a skillion roof to the rear and a separate verandah roof to the front. The front verandah is supported on timber posts with a fibro balustrade to one half and fibro infill to the other and the verandah ends. The verandah is accessed via timber steps with timber handrails. The property has a stone wall to the front boundary.
