Situated on the south west corner of the intersection of Kennedy and Georgina Roads, the former Georgina Methodist Chapel is a simple stone church with a steeply pitched corrugated iron roof. The building features Gothic arched windows which are enhanced by brick quoining; this also being evident on the corners. There is a stone lean-to to the rear. The front facade is symmetrical with a window either side of the central Gothic arched timber door. There are brick buttresses to the corners and a turned timber finial to the gable apex.

2004/05 Review: A corrugated iron leanto with connecting passageway has been built on the west side of the church.

The former Georgina Methodist Chapel has high historic and social significance for its connection with the religious activities of the local community for many years. The place has considerable aesthetic value given its simple form and style and use of local materials. The significance of the former chapel is enhanced by its close proximity to the former Georgina State School. The place makes an important contribution to the built heritage of the Greenough district.
