This small and simple two roomed stone cottage is currently being extended and renovated. The cottage has a steeply pitched corrugated iron gable roof with a broken back extension to cover the front (west) verandah which is bowed.

2004/05 Review: There is evidence of lean-to additions to the east and north walls. The place is subject to substantial modifications by the present owner including rammed earth/concrete additions and being incorporated into a large steel framed structure.
