The place has a gable colorbond roof which extends to cover an enclosed verandah to the Jose Street frontage. The original concrete tiled roof has been replaced with colorbond roof sheeting. There is a lean to roof to the rear.

In the early 1950s the local community decided that an Infant Health Centre was needed in the town. An energetic committee was formed and numerous fundraising activities were held. Meanwhile busy-bees produced the many thousands of bricks needed to construct the building. The Mullewa Infant Health Centre was opened on 28 June 1955, by the Hon Emil Nulsen, Minister for Health.
