



## STAKEHOLDER APPROVAL FOR FIREWORKS FROM THE ESPLANADE

Due to the impact on Mid-West Ports (Port) operations and the need for the Department of Transport (DoT) to regulate and police the water ways during Fireworks events from the City's Esplanade, the City of Greater Geraldton (City) requires all Fireworks companies to obtain written approval from both the Port and DoT, prior the City endorsing an event Fireworks Event Notice.

Firework companies are also advised that due to location conditions and on-going weather impacts on Fireworks events from the Esplanade – the City, Port and DoT require that all Firework events must have a **Boating Exclusion Zone of no less than 500 metres**.
