

**Local Government Act 1995**

**City of Greater Geraldton Public Places and Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2021**

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Greater Geraldton resolved on dd mm 2021 to make the following local law:

**1. Citation**

This local law is cited as the *City of Greater Geraldton Public Places and Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2021*.

**2. Commencement**

This local law comes into operation 14 days after its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

**3. City of Greater Geraldton Public Places and Local Government Property Local Law 2020 amended**

(1) In this local law the *City of Greater Geraldton Public Places and Local Government Property Local Law 2020* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 5 January 2021 is referred to as the principal local law.

(2) In clause 1.5 of the principal local law the definition of ‘authorised person is replaced with:

**authorised person** means a person appointed by the CEO under section 9.10 of the Act to perform any of the functions of an authorised person under this local law;

(3) Clause 5.5 of the principal local law is deleted and replaced with:

**5.5 Animals**

(1) Unless authorised by a written law, permit or under this local law, a person must not:

(a) tether any animal to a tree, shrub, tree guard, wall or fence on local government property; or

(b) permit any animal to enter upon or into any local government property.

(2) In subclause (1), ‘animal’ does not include a dog or an ‘assistance animal’ as defined in section 9(2) of the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Cth)*.

(4) In clause 7.1 of the principal local law the definitions of ‘protected fauna’ and ‘rare fauna’ are deleted and replaced with the following:

**protected flora** has the meaning given to it in Part 10, Division 2 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*;

**rare flora** has the meaning given to it in Regulation 168 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2018*;
