**RE: Sand and Limestone Pits – Walter Rd, Walkaway  
Development Approval application**

Kimberley Quarries is pleased to submit documentation in support of the development of sand and limestone pits in Walter Rd Walkaway, South of Geraldton.

The land is owned by Michael Cornelius Culloton and is zoned rural with extractive industries a permitted use.

The processes involved in the production of sand include:

- Excavate and haul
- Screening (if required)
- Stockpiling and load out
- Transport and delivery

The processes involved in the production of limestone products include:

- Loading and hauling
- Crushing and screening
- Stockpiling and load out
- Transport and delivery

It is likely that the pits will only operate when a sale is made which may be 4 or 5 days per month for most of the year. The pits are unlikely to operate at the same time.

The development is likely to employ 4 or 5 people both during establishment and operations. Working hours are to be 7am – 5pm Monday to Saturday, maybe maintenance work on Sunday if required. In a sales' only mode, only 2 people will be required.

There is likely to be emissions of noise, dust, vibration and an impact from vehicular traffic, however, the attached Mining Proposal will demonstrate how the impact of these can be kept to a minimum, acceptable to the surrounding community. There will be little or no impact from smell, light, electrical interference, fumes, smoke or waste.

Approximately 7 pieces of crushing and earthmoving equipment will be utilised on the site. All will be state of the art, near new and reliable.

None of the equipment will generate noise in excess of the allowable 85dB and noise levels at nearest neighbours will not exceed Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997.

Truck movements will be restricted to cause minimal disturbance to nearby residences. Two or three trucks will be required four or five days/month.
