Local Assets and Local Funding The purpose of this section is to protect and maintain the assets of the former Shire of Mullewa and the former City of Geraldton-Greenough for the future of the local communities. The City of Geraldton-Greenough and the Shire of Mullewa strongly supported the identification of local assets and local funding reserves owned and generated by local communities for use and benefit in the future for those communities. The new local government City of Greater Geraldton shall work towards the following principles: 1.1. All assets will be managed and maintained in accordance to the best practice model of Aus-Spec, or equivalent alternate best practice system, in accordance with agreed service level agreements; 1.2. All assets and infrastructure will be budgeted in accordance with WAAMI principles, or equivalent alternate best practice system, through a 5-year budget process; 1.3. All existing reserves and restricted funds will be maintained into the future for their current specified purpose and within the originally prescribed geographic boundaries; and 1.4. It is understood that the Shire of Mullewa owned houses in their community. If a future council changed the purpose or disposed of these properties, all funds would be placed in a restricted fund or reserve for the purpose of special projects and improvements within the Mullewa ward.	1.
